Title – Multilog LX Time correction

### Question –

How do Multilog LX's correct their time?

### Answer –

This depends on the logger type and how it is transferring its data.

If it's a UDP logger calling into Toran/Datagate, it will only correct it's time if the time is out by more than 5min for 3 consecutive call-ins.

If it is an SMS logger, it will send itself an SMS once per month and use this to correct its time. (Loggers could drift 1~3min per month depending on environmental conditions)

If it's a logger calling into Datagate via FTP2, then the logger will send itself an SMS once per month and use this to correct its time. (Loggers could drift 1~3min per month depending on environmental conditions)

It is important that the correct SMS number is programmed into the logger at the time of installation – the SMS number must match the number of the fitted SIM card.
