Setup the Bluetooth connection between the PC/Tablet and the Patroller; (Based on a WIN7 PC) – Insert the Bluetooth Dongle (if required) in an available USB port, wait for the drivers to be installed, then look at "Devices and Printers", Right Click on the Icon and select "Bluetooth Settings"
