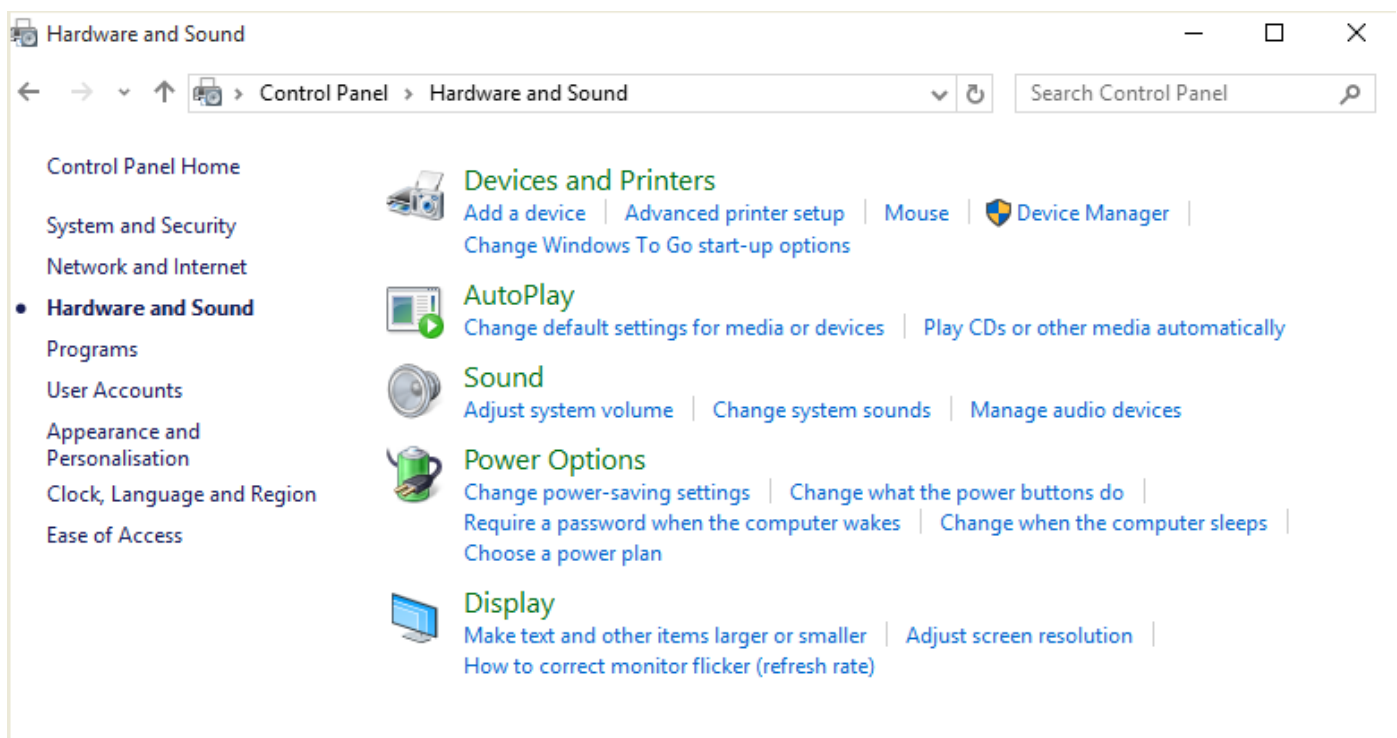

How to pair a Patroller to a Windows 10 PC with PC Patroller software installed

This guide details how to connect the Patroller II to the PC either by Direct cable or by Bluetooth connection.

Direct cable –

Use your windows explorer/ PC explore to find Device manager (It's in Control Panel > Hardware and Printers)



Plug in the cable and check you can see it against a COM port – if you can't, you may need to install the driver for the direct USB or USB/Serial connector you are using.



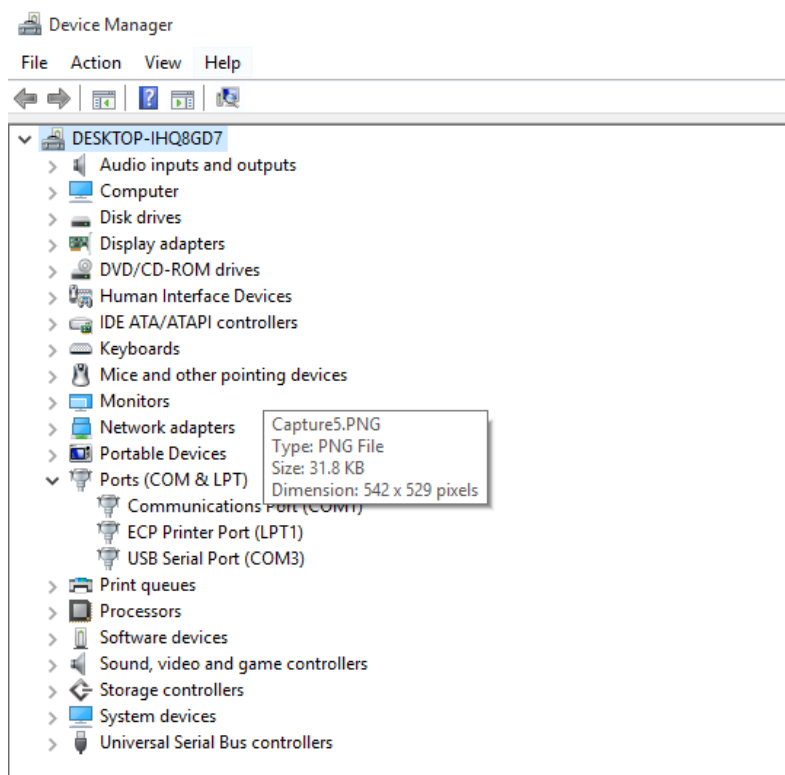

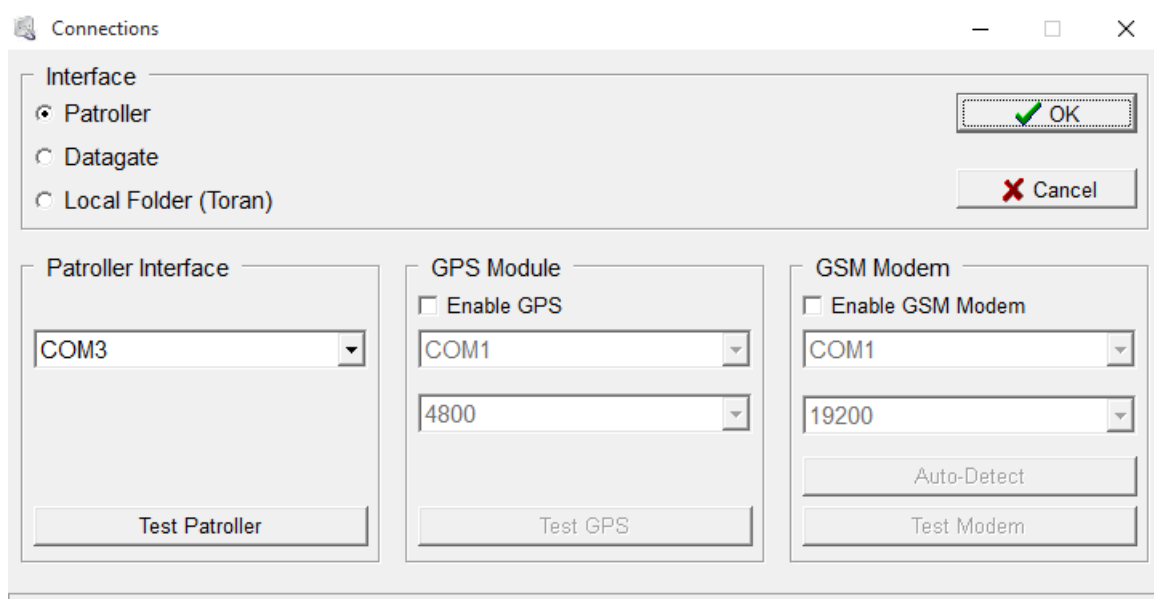

Once you can see the connection port (3 above), open PC Patroller software and then you should be able to select the port from the drop down and test the comms to the Patroller by selecting the 'Test Patroller' button:-

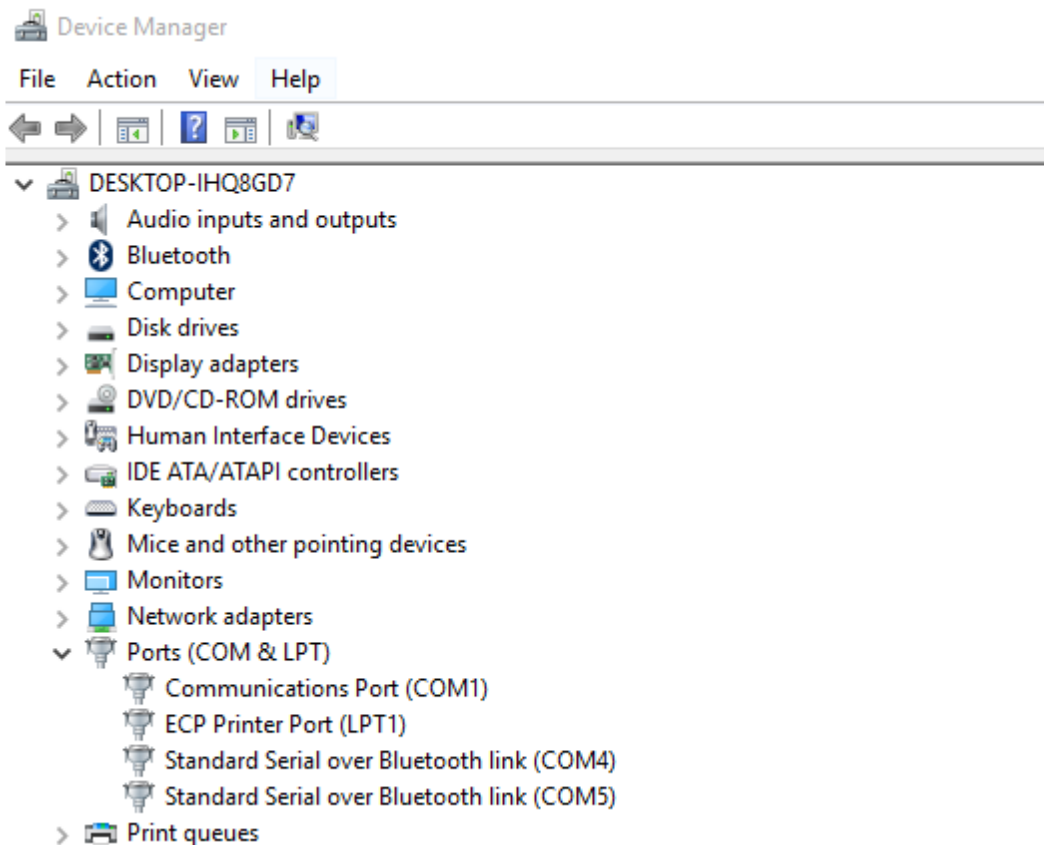

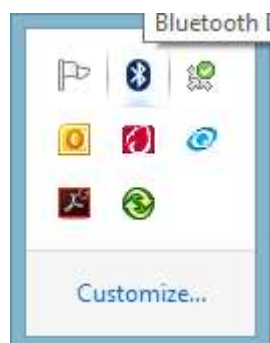

Blue tooth

Again you need to find control panel and check the Bluetooth dongle is connected to the PC ok (might need to install it?) or if the PC has integral Bluetooth in it then miss out this step and go to the next -



Then click on the Blue tooth icon in the tray -



And Bluetooth should start to search for nearby devices to pair with.
Switch on the Patroller and you should see it appear in the Bluetooth list



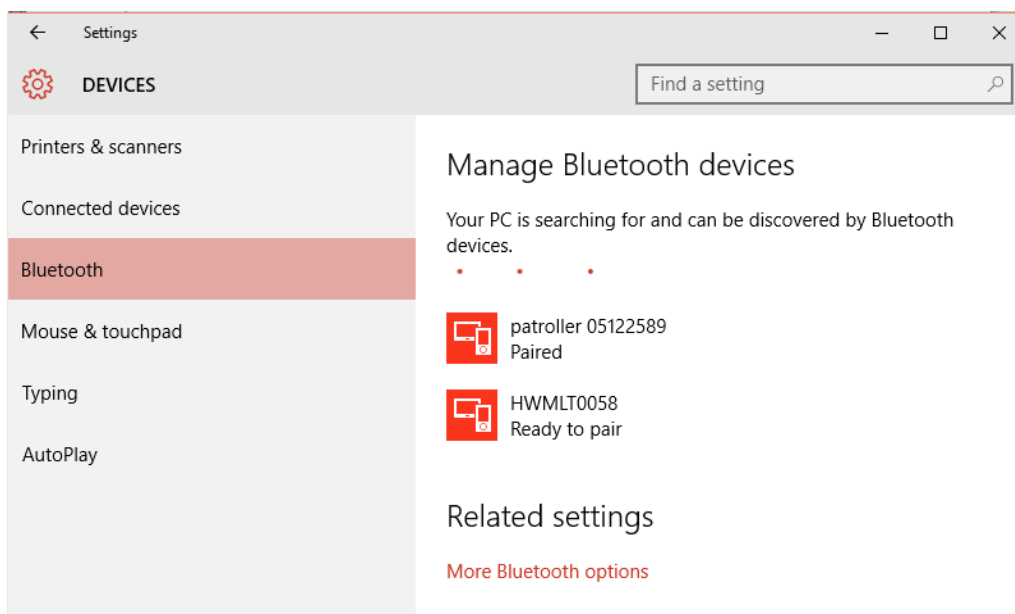

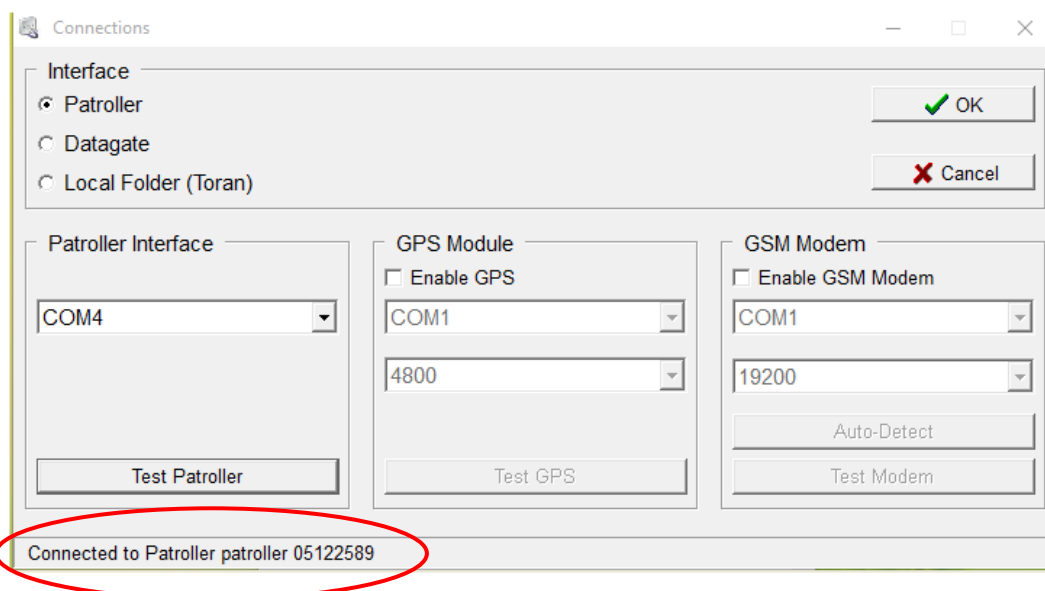
