Title – Permalog+ operating modes

Permalog + explanation of different operating modes

Patrol Mode (which is same as Default settings) is when the P+ transmits its leak data every 2 seconds and listens for command every 40 seconds; patrols last for 8 hours per day.

Fixed Network Mode is where the P+ transmits its leak data every 8 seconds and listens for command every 16 seconds; patrols last 24 hours per day.

Lift & Shift has no patrol window (no radio settings) – you pick up the Permalog, swipe it with a magnet to switch it on - It transmits the data to the Patroller for approx 60 seconds and then the radio goes back into sleep mode automatically (it is of course still recording data – only the radio has gone to sleep)

. How can you check if a particular Permalog is in Fixed Network or Patrol Mode?

You cannot check this..... but you can get a good indication by looking at the individual Permalogs settings in the Patrol Window Screen –

- a. If the boxes are checked 8am to 4 pm it is likely to be in patrol Mode
- b. If all the boxes are checked 12am to 12pm it is likely to be in Fixed Network Mode
- c. If none of the boxes is checked is set it is likely to be in lift & shift mode
