Title – Radwin screens for TC65i Modem

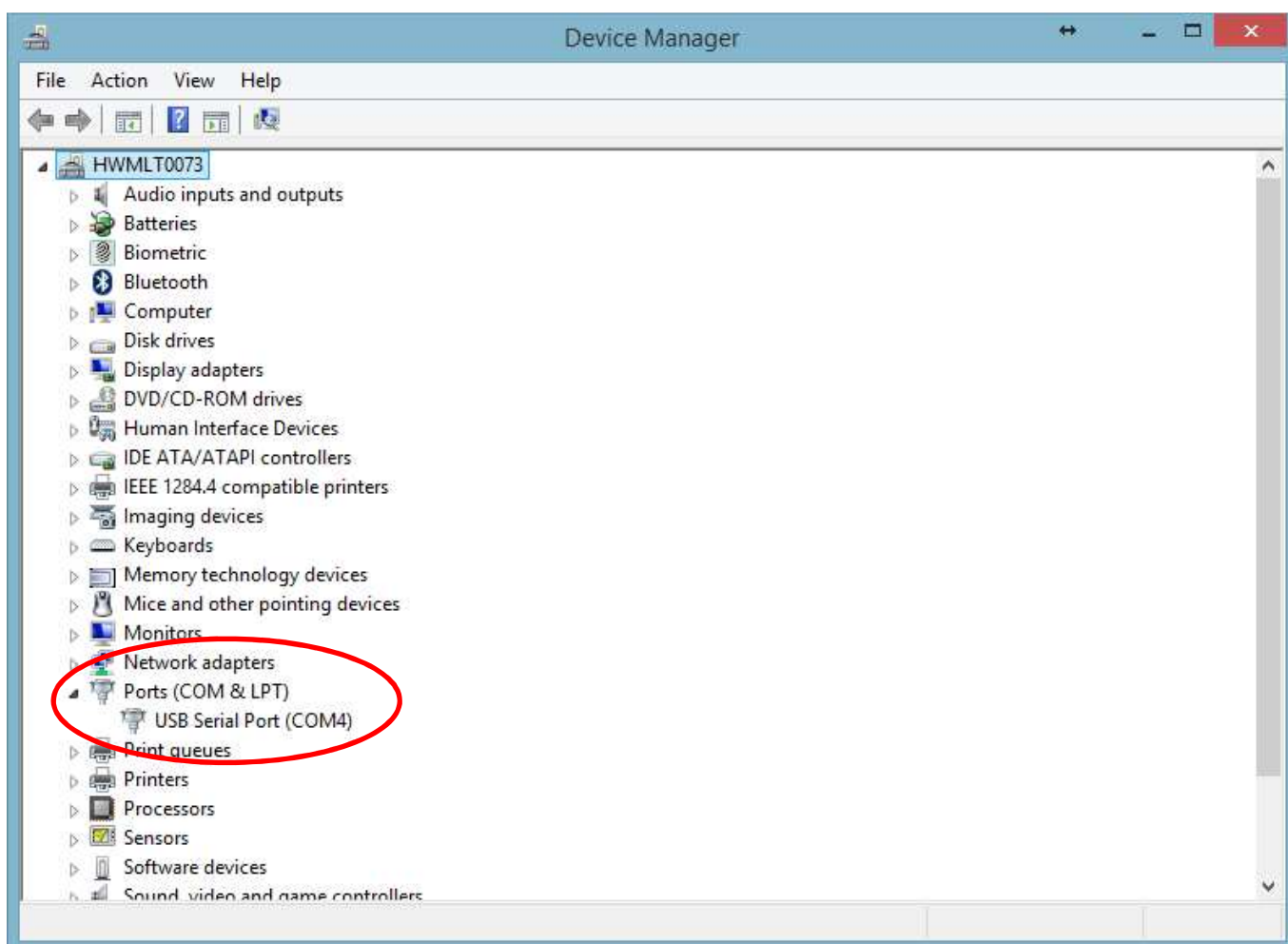

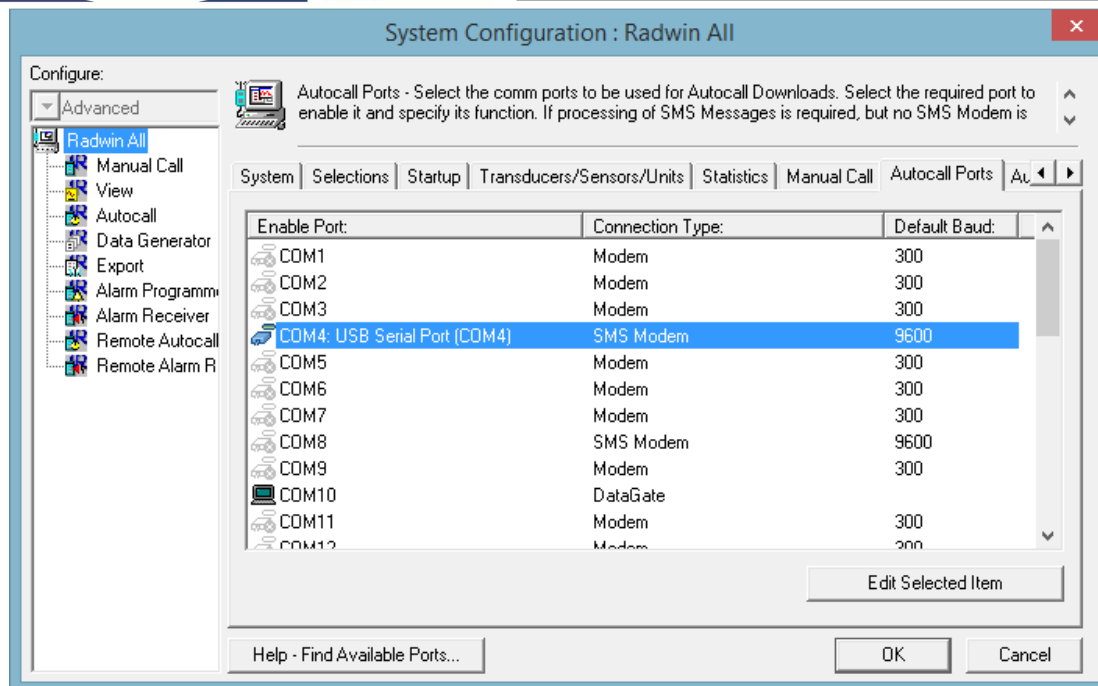
Question – What should the configuration of the TC65i modem look like in Radwin

If you follow the manual for installation and testing of the TC65i modem with your Radwin software the settings should be as follows -

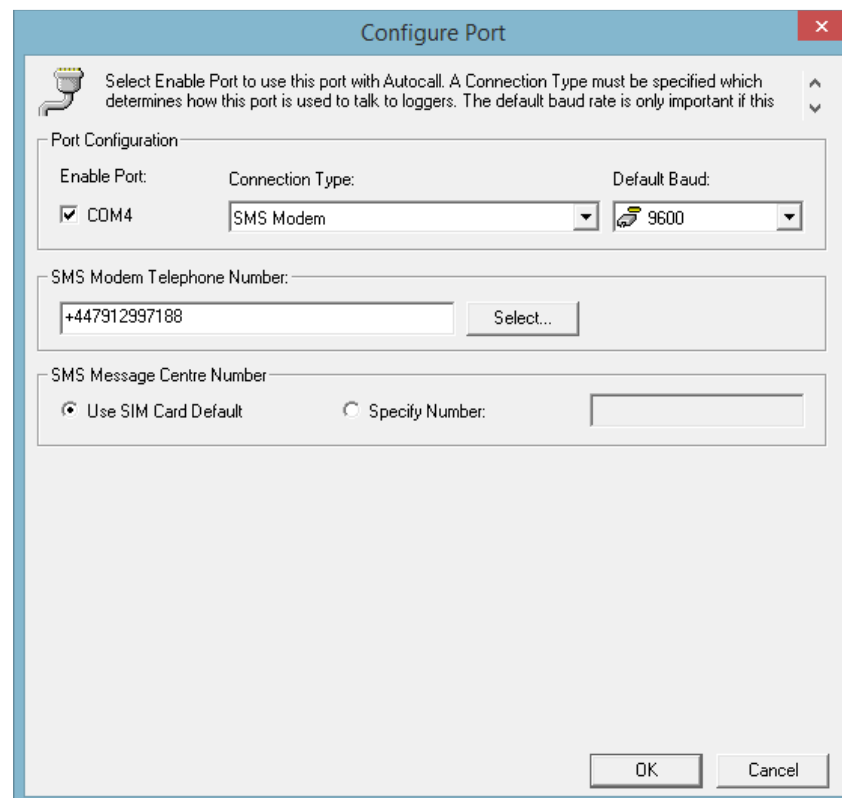
1. From your PC Control panel > Device manager to confirm the port number the Modem is connected to – (in this case COM 4)



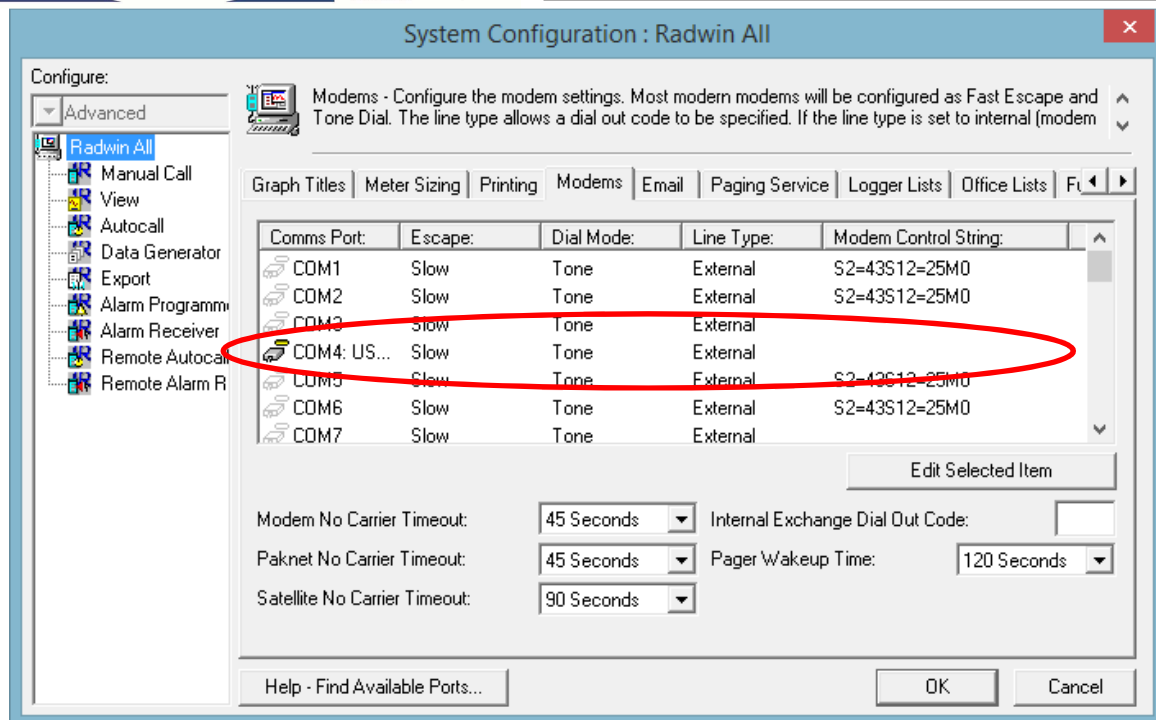
2. Now open Radwin View and select Radwin System Configuration > Autocall ports tab



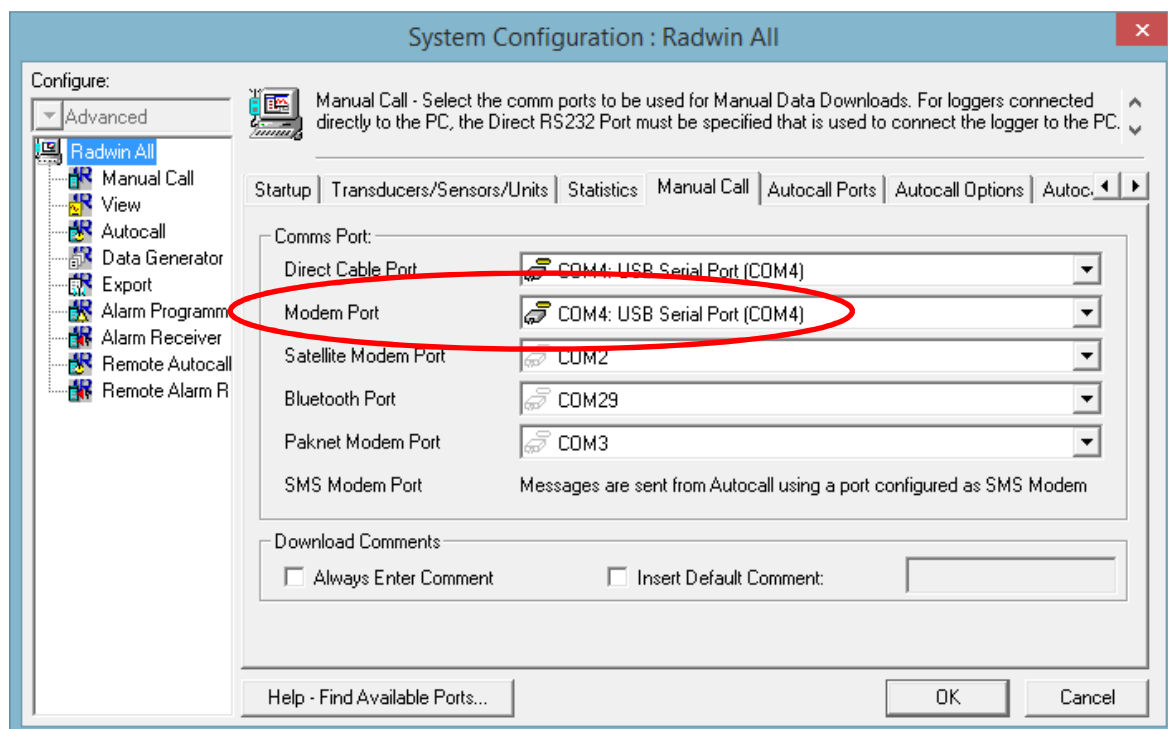
- Double click on the modem port (in this example it is COM 4) – ensure Enable box is ticked, SMS modem is selected, 9600 Baud rate and the Modem SIM phone number in international format is entered -



- Radwin System Configuration >Modem tab (check the Modem control string has been removed)



- And then the Radwin System Configuration > Manual Call tab (check the Modem port icon is coloured)



- Radwin System Configuration > Autocall options tab - settings as below -



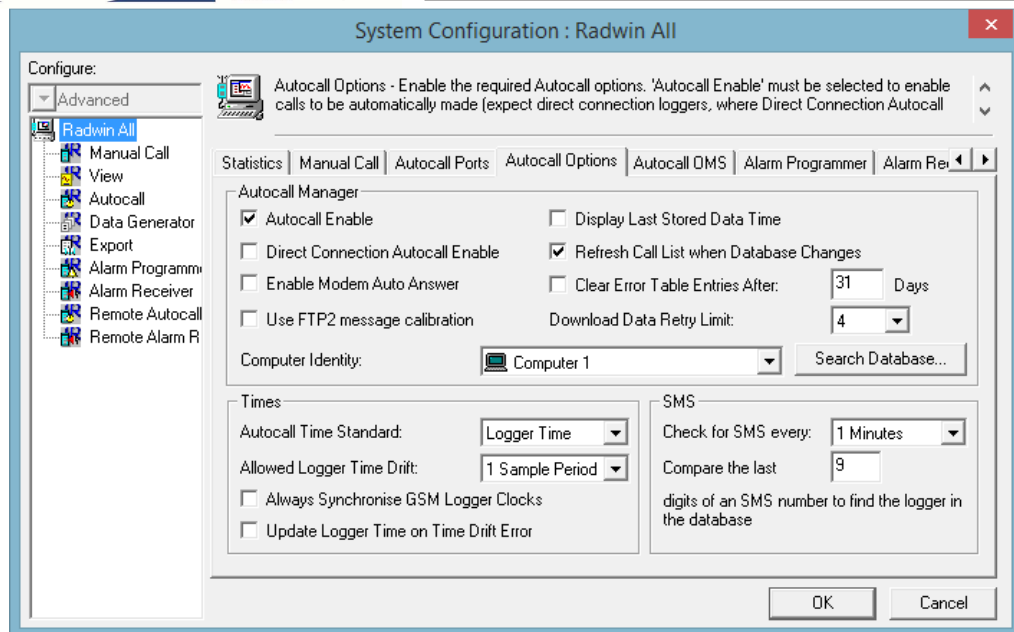
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Ensure that at each stage OK is selected to ensure the settings are confirmed and that that Radwin software is shut down and re-opened to ensure the settings are retained for future operation
