How to set up 'Offices' to restrict views of a Database contents

This guide describes how to select only a few loggers from a large database in Radwin.

This below shows you how a particular a person using Radwin on his/her PC can view only a certain number of loggers within the main database (which may be held on a server).

To do this - If you open Radwin software and in Radwin Set Up > System Configuration > Office lists you should see the screen shot below.

This enables you to set up a series of 'Offices' relating to your preferred groups of loggers. (remember to tick the Enable Office Selection box when you have set up the offices)

If you then Open the main database through Radwin View – go to the loggers you want in a specific 'office,' highlight the logger, right click on it, select 'Location Database' and then 'Edit location' to reveal the below screen shot and associate the



required logger with your preferred Office. Do this for each of the loggers concerned.
