


## How to delete zones and Locations (loggers) from a Radwin database

### Deletion of Locations (Loggers) from a Radwin database -

In Radwin Software open the View module and select the 'Open Data File' Icon at the top left hand side of the screen -




With the Data base open expand out each Zone by clicking on the '+' to its left





Locate the logger you wish to remove -




and Right mouse click on it – then select Location Database > Delete Location -



Confirm this is the logger location you wish to delete (and if necessary remove any Function sets it is associated with) and then Select 'OK' – you will then get the caution warning below -



Selecting 'Yes' will confirm the action and delete the database location.


### Deletion of Zones from a Database -

A similar process can be used to delete the Zone- but this can only be done when all the loggers in the Zone have been deleted. It is not possible to delete a zone which still has locations in it.

Select the Zone and right click on it –
