Adding the location identity and name is the minimum amount of information required. Click Save to create the new Location.

Guide to adding a new Data Logger to the database...

- 1. Open Radwin Setup.
- 2. Open Item Configuration.
- 3. Double click the Zone.
- 4. Start to create new location (instructions on page 7).
- 5. Click the Logger tab.
- 6. Use the drop down menu to change the logger type
- 7. Change the connection
- 8. Add the telephone or SMS number of the logger.
- 9. Enter the logger serial number to the serial number box (optional).
- 10. Click the Autocall tab.

The following instructions are NOT applicable to SMS loggers.

- 11. For GSM and PSTN loggers click the tick box to enable Autocall.
- 12. Enter the call out time.
- 13. Select tomorrows date in the box next to the time. This is the date the first download will take place.

These instructions are applicable to ALL loggers.

- 14. Click the Transducer tab
- 15. Use the Channel drop down menu, and select each recording channel in turn. Ensure the transducer type is correct (i.e. pressure or flow) and also check the sensor type below. If the sensor type needs to be changed then click Configure and change the Sensor type to reflect correctly the data being recorded.
- 16. Click Save to update the location
