




## Radwin Database – how to find and interpret the SMS archive

To find your SMS archive, navigate to the folder where your Radwin Database is located.

If you are unsure of where your Radwin database is located, if you have not changed the database path, you can locate this by opening Radcom Setup. Then click Options → System Configuration...




If you have not changed your database path, the Radwin database will be stored here (see ringed area).



Use your computers Explore facility (right click the start button and select 'Explore') to find the Radwin Software and its associated Database Folder



Open the Data folder


When you are within your Radwin database folder, navigate to the 'smsarchive' folder




The 'smsarchive' folder contains a list of all numbers where messages have been sent. Navigate to and open the Text Document file for the phone number that you wish to view.
