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IMPORTANT INFORMATION

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For standard operation of the Patroller II PDA software, and for technical information of equipments, please refer to the Patroller II User manual MAN-096-0001-I or later issue.

This manual is intended for Administrator usage and it is assumed that the Administrator is familiar with Patroller II PDA software or has read the User's manual (MAN-096-0001).

There is no longer any password access for a normal user. What a normal user could access is now determined entirely by the Administrator. It is important that the Administrator determines what is necessary for the end user to access, and provide access to those features.

Every time the software is upgraded, it is important that "PDA Setup" is enabled by the Administrator to link the Patroller II Interface unit to the correct PDA. A normal user need not ever access this screen. However for convenience, it might be useful to allow a normal user to use the "PDA Setup" icon.

Important: On every installation or update of Patroller II PDA Software, it is important to reestablish the Bluetooth link between the PDA and the Interface unit it is supposed to be connected to. Please refer to the Patroller II User Manual (MAN-096-0001). Default Main Icons Screen on First Installation

Default Main Icons Screen on First Installation

Figure 1 shows the default user access screen after the first installing 4.4.0.5/4.4.0.6 version of Patroller II PDA Software.

Notice that only the **Section** available here.

For version after V4.4.0X, the application will automatically restore the screen settings permitted by the Administrator and Distributor.

It is up to the Administrator to decide what the user should be able to access via the Administrator Pass-code access only screen.

Figure 1 shows that the only "Menu" option available is that of "Option (Pass-code Access Only)".

Figure 1 shows the Main Icons screen with one Menu Option "Option (Pass-code Access Only)".

The default Administrator pass-code is "admin". It is very important for the Administrator to change the pass-code as soon as the software installation has completed to prevent unauthorized access to the software and its database.

Pass-code Screen

On clicking the menu option shown in *Figure 1*, the Pass-code access screen will come into focus as shown in *Figure 2*.

Enter the Administrator pass-code. The default Administrator's pass-code is "admin". However if you have already changed the pass-code, please use your own pass-code.

It is important to note that pass-codes are case sensitive.

Administrator Pass-code Access Only Screens

Administrator Pass-code Access Only Screens

On successfully entering the correct Administrator's pass-code, the PDA screen will be taken to the Administrator Pass-code Access Only Screens.

In this screen, there are by default only two tab pages:

- Features
- Password

Additional tab pages will appear if an item checked in the "Features" Tab page contains additional tab pages.

Password Tab Page

The password tab page shown in Figure 3, allows the Administrator to change the login passcode/password of the Administrator.

It is important that the Administrator:

- 1. Knows the original Administrator's password.
- 2. Remembers the new password

Default Administrator Password

The default Administrator password is "admin"

(Note that password is case sensitive and NULL entry is not permitted.)

Features Tab Page

Features Tab Page

The Features tab page shown in *Figure 4*, allows the Administrator to determine what a normal user is allowed to access.

Example: If the normal user's task for the day is just to Patrol, it is unnecessary for him to have access to the remaining features in the PDA.

Restriction is in place to prevent unauthorized changes to the database by an untrained user. Also there is no need for the normal user to learn the entire application if all they could access are the same few icons that they use on a daily basis.

For details for what individual features when enabled perform in the Main Icons Screen, please refer to MAN-096-0001.

Table 1 shows the icons that could be shown on the Main Icons Screen for each check box checked in the Administrator's Features Tab page.

Administrator Option: Menu->Database Import/Export

Administrator Option: Menu->Database Import/Export

This option allows the user to use the menu option to import Permalog CSV file into the database. This option also allows the end user to export a particular DMA into Permalog CSV file format.

When Menu->Database Import/Export is unchecked, the Main icons screen will look like *Figure 6*.

See Figure 11 to know where in the Deploy screen Administrator permitted features affect.

Set P+ Clock on Deploy

If the Administrator \checkmark this option, on deploying the P+ logger, the Interface unit will automatically send a radio message out to the P+ being deployed to set the logger Real-time clock. And in the Deploy screen, the user will be permitted to manually establish connection between the Patroller II Interface unit and the PDA, if the connection is not already established.

Should the Bluetooth connection between the PDA and Patroller Interface unit be established, but the Administrator has not \checkmark this option, the P+ Clock will not be set on Deploy.

Allow Logger Deletion

If the Administrator \checkmark this option, on deploying the P+ logger, the "Delete" menu option in the "Permalog Details" screen will be enabled.

The Permalog Details Screen is a sub screen of the Deploy screen. See Figure 11.

Default options as shown in *Figure 16* for *Table 7*. With the exception of the option "Change Logger Setup After Lift", none of the options on this screen affect how the Lift + Shift screen is displayed to the end user.

Check the checkbox option for "Change Logger Setup After Lift" and return to the user accessible Lift + Shift Screen (See Figure 17). Notice that unlike Figure 15, which had three tab pages, there are now two additional tab pages for "Patrol Window" and "Logging Days".

If Add 29 Days Level & Spread to Database is checked, when the logger latest and 28 day level and spread History read being read from the logger, the level and spread history read will also be automatically written into the database.

If Allow Delete Leak History After Download is checked, when the logger latest and 28 day level and spread history is being read, it will automatically delete the logger 28 day history after download.
